Re: Notice concerning the **August 2022 Graduate School Special Entrance Examination for International Students** for foreign nationals residing abroad

In accordance with Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (MEXT) guidelines, we will conduct an entrance examination for international students from August 22 to 24, 2022, in a face-to-face session on the KIT campus, in principle, taking measures to prevent infection. However, as the Japanese government has established quarantine measures for persons entering Japan, such as entry restrictions and periods of isolation after entry to prevent the spread of the novel coronavirus, foreign examinees living abroad who cannot enter Japan will be able to take the entrance examination online. The application period remains unchanged: Thursday, June 23 to Thursday, June 30, 2022. To assure that required documents arrive within the application period, overseas applicants are advised to prepare and post the application and accompanying documents well in advance.
