

Tuition Payment and Account Registration

1. Tuition Fee Amounts and Payment Deadlines

Tuition fees for the academic year should be paid in two installments: one for the first semester and one for the second semester. The amounts and deadlines are as follows:

	Amount Due	Payment Deadline
Spring Semester Tuition	267,900 yen	The last day of April*
Fall Semester Tuition	267,900 yen	The last day of October*
Total Annual Tuition	535,800 yen	

**If the last day of the month falls on a weekend or public holiday, the payment deadline will be the previous business day.*

2. Tuition Payment Method

- As a general rule, tuition fees should be paid via direct debit from a bank or postal account.

Spring semester tuition direct debit payment date	Fall semester tuition direct debit payment date
April 27	October 27

- If the last day of the month falls on a weekend or public holiday, the payment deadline will be the previous business day.*
- Direct debit (withdrawal) fees will be covered by KIT.*

3. Direct Debit Account Registration

Account Registration Period: Monday, April 6, 2026, to Sunday, April 12, 2026.

Registration must be completed within the timeframe above.

If you miss the registration deadline, your direct debit scheduled for April 27 will not occur, and you will be seen as not having paid. If you have not registered your account, do so promptly. We will perform the direct debit again the following month.

Note: If you are applying for tuition exemption or deferment, you do not need to register a direct debit account at this time. Register your account after receiving the result of your exemption or deferment application.

Information Required for Registration:

- Student ID number (Student ID cards will be issued on April 6)
- Student date of birth (use the Gregorian calendar year)
- Bank account information (Account in the student's, a parent's, or guarantor's name)
- PIN or password for your cash card, etc.

Note: The required information and available registration hours may vary by financial institution. See the Mitsubishi UFJ Factor website for details.

4. Important:

- Ensure that the amount of your tuition fee is deposited into the registered account by the business day before the scheduled payment date. If there are insufficient funds and the direct debit cannot be processed, it will be retried on the 27th of the following month (if the 27th falls on a weekend or public holiday, the payment will be processed on the next business day).
- The direct debit transaction can be confirmed in your bankbook (the transaction will be listed as "NS コウセンダイ" or "DF コウセンダイ").
- Paid tuition fees are, in principle, non-refundable. If you are considering taking a leave of absence or withdrawing, consult the Educational Affairs Office before making the payment.
