Acceptance Approval and Guide to obtaining a student visa (K)	KIT sends a letter of acceptance to each student and an application guide of CoE (Certificate of Eligibility), which is required for student visa application.	November to December	April to May	November to December	April to May

Submission of CoE application to the Immigration Office in Japan (K)	KIT apply for CoE to the Immigration office.
