授業の目的・概要 Objectives and Outline of the Course

- ∃ This class has three main goals:
 - 1. Enhance academic discussion skills
 - 2. Improve university-level English reading & listening
 - 3. Acquisition of academic level vocabulary in context
- 英 Battlestar Galactica: A Media Studies Approach to studying Society, Technology, & War

This class will focus on academic discussion of serious contemporary issues connected to issues of technology, wary and public policy. Of particular focus will be: just war theory, racism, and philosophical questions about what it means to be "human". Sudents will practice making verbal arguments, taking a point of view and explaining your reasoning. You will also have to give one presentation at the end of the se-mester on a topic of your choice. Topics & issues will come from watching the first season of the American TV drama, Battlestar Galactica.

The focus of this class is academic communication, so listening (to the drama & other students) and speaking are emphasized; but other English skills will also be used: writing (discussion preparation, short essays), reading (scripts and related articles), and vocabulary (from episode scripts) will also be important.
