授業の目的・概要 Objectives and Outline of the Course

日 この授業では前学期に引き続き、文法練習だけでなく会話表現や文章の読解などを通して総合的なドイツ語の語学力を身につけるための訓練を行います。

また言語の学習と併せて、ドイツ語圏の文化や社会についての理解を深めてゆくことも目標としています。

This German course is aimed at the students after attending "Elementary German: Grammar A" and "Elementary German: Reading A", and to introduce students to the strategies and skills how to communicate in German. Students choosing this course will be required to take the courses of "Elementary German: Grammar B". This course is taught in Japanese. The advantage of learning German as a third language is to help not only understanding of the country Germany, but also its people and culture. All students will be required to engage in reading, writing and listening exercises both in and outside of class.

∃ 【履修の鉄則

- (i) 前期に扱った文法単元を前提として進みます。教科書巻末の動詞の不規則変化形は、できるだけ休み期間中に各自で取り組んでください。
- (ii) 前期の授業でドイツ語にも親しみを持ってもらえたかと思います。後期の文法単元をこなせば、古典的テクストも読むこ

とができることを体感してもらいます。

(iii) 異なる文法体系を持つドイツ語を習得することは、日本語の鍛え直しにもつながります。

ドイツ語をすぐに使うことはないかもしれませんが、日本語でのレポート、論文執筆等にも必ず活きて来ますから、じっくりと取り組んでください。

英 [Hard-and-fast rule of study]

- (i) It is a must for an English-speaking Japanese active in an international arena to use a second European language at a practical level of proficiency because it will work as a clue to more deeply understand not only the English language but also the American and British modern societies. This view may be shared by the citizens in these two countries who have finished their mid-level education.
- (ii) Since German is a subject in which students, as a result of their endeavor, may be able to mark a high GPA score, they are invited to take the course positively.
- (iii) This, however, does not mean that you should only attend the German lessons calmly but it requires you to positively take part in them. At the same time, studying German will provide you with synergetic effects along with other college studies, which will revitalize your concentration and endeavor.

授業時間外学習(予習·復習等)

Required study time, Preparation and review

日【受講の鉄則】

- (i) 毎回の授業で次回までの課題と予習箇所を指示します。必ず、指示した箇所を自力で解いて授業に臨んでください。
- (ii) 途中でつまづくようなことがあれば、既習の文法単元の理解度が及んでいない可能性があるので、適宜復習してください。
- (iii) 面倒くさがらずに辞書を引き、手と口を動かして、体に染み込ませるように学んでください。

英 [Hard-and-fast rule of taking the course]

- (i) The second foreign language class is not something that allows a student to just sit there during the lessons but urges him/ her to positively take part in them. The student will have to maintain greater concentration and efforts than in any other subjects so that he/she may not forget all about the lesson upon its ending.
- (ii) The grammar of a second foreign language may become understandable step by step. So, remember that what is being taught in the current lesson is logically continued from what you learned in the previous lesson.
- (iii) It may be ideal to master a second foreign language by getting accustomed to it but it is often impossible to do so due to a shortage of time. So, you will need to understand all the key points in mind and practice what you learned by using your mouth and hands until you can speak and write without reviewing the textbook.

成績評価の方法及び基準 Grading Policy

日 学期末試験を60%、課題や予習への取り組み等、授業への積極性を40%として評価し、その合計点が60点以上を合格とする。

なお遅刻3回をもって欠席1回と同等の扱いをする。

著しく授業態度が悪い場合は、減点する。試験の点数が著しく低い場合も即座に不可とする。

英 Grades will be based on: (1) the total of quiz and exam results (55%); and (2) positive approaches to assignments and class

sessions (45%). Students with a total score of 60 points or over will pass the course.

Students who simply attend the class without "participation", or those who do not make preparation or complete assignments as instructed, will be considered as "absentees".

In addition, students with inappropriate behavior in class (such as chatting, napping or cell phone operation), as well as those with repeated absences, late arrivals or walkouts for no justifiable reason, will not be allowed to take the final exam. (As a general rule, students who miss more than three classes will be unqualified to take the exam.)

* Students having any justifiable reason for their act should prepare all necessary documents and report to the teacher at least three weeks prior to the final exam.

Students should note before taking this course that, in some cases, their midterm exam results may not allow their continued attendance at subsequent classes.
