5	日	Paragraph Review; Public Speaking	Students will review what they have learned about paragraph writing, and will also begin to prepare their first speech presentation.

6	日	Writing Assignment 1 - In class	Students will have their first writing assessment. This will be done in class, without the use of devices. Students will then have time to practice their speeches.

7	日	Speech Presentations	Students will present their first informative speeches.

8	日	Essay Structure and Poster Presentation Preparation - 1	Students will learn the basics of Essay structure. Students will be introduced to the Poster Presentation assignment, and will make groups to begin their preparations.

9	日	Essay Structure and Poster Presentation Preparation - 2	Students will continue to learn the basics of Essay structure, and will continue to work on their poster presentations. Students will also spend some time reviewing the speaking skills of sharing their opinions, and agreeing & disagreeing.

10	日	Poster Presentation Preparation - 3	Students will receive feedback on the draft of their posters, and will practice their presentations.
