英	<p>This 15-week course is designed for students with a TOEIC score of around 700-800. It aims to enhance English language skills through the exploration of various media forms. The course will cover podcasts, internet news, broadcast news, YouTube, films, and various other forms of media.</p> <p>Each weekly class will consist of the following elements:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1: A brief historical outline.</li> <li>2: An analysis of language and techniques used.</li> <li>3: Cultural impact.</li> </ol> <p>* The syllabus is subject to change depending on the ability of students and external conditions</p> <p>The class is learner-centred and collaborative. The class is designed to encourage the sharing of ideas in English. There will also be Powerpoint presentations, select readings, videos, and activities provided by the teacher. The students will therefore be required to participate in the form of in-class discussions and feedback sessions at the end of each session to deepen the student's understanding of the subject material.</p> <p>All class materials and some supplementary materials will be available to all students on Google Classroom/Moodle.</p>
