英	<p>This 8-week course is designed to enhance the intercultural communication skills of EFL graduate students in Japan. The course will explore various aspects of intercultural communication through the lens of English as a Foreign Language. Students will engage with different cultures, understand communication barriers, and develop practical communication skills that are essential in a globalized world.</p> <p>The course will be learner-centered and collaborative, encouraging the sharing of ideas through discussions, and group work. Each class will include interactive activities, discussions, and lectures. Supplementary materials will be available on Google Classroom/Moodle. The students will therefore be required to participate in the form of in-class discussions and feedback sessions at the end of each session to deepen the student's understanding of the subject material.</p> <p>All class materials and some supplementary materials will be available to all students on Google Classroom/Moodle.</p>
